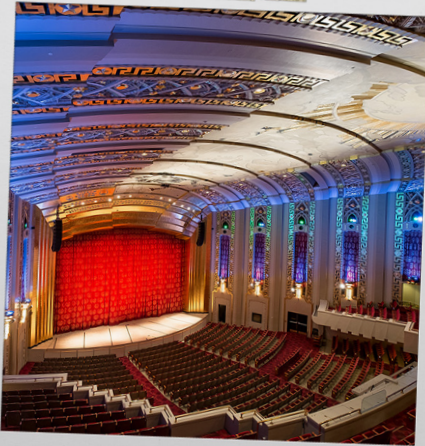

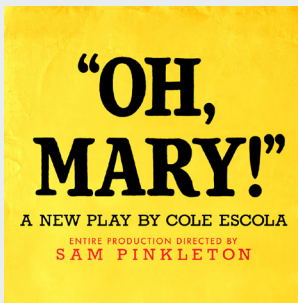

JUNE 1 – 3, 2027

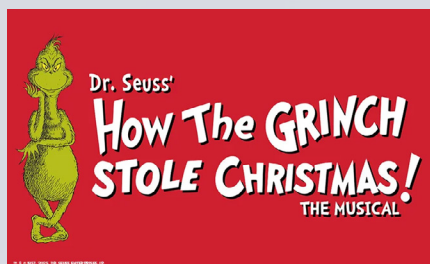

NOVEMBER 18 – 22, 2026

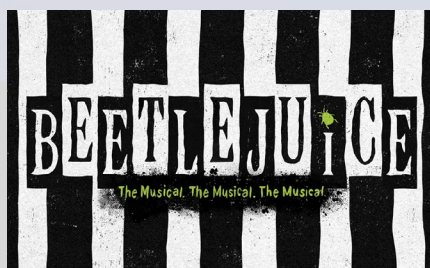

JANUARY 22 – 23, 2027

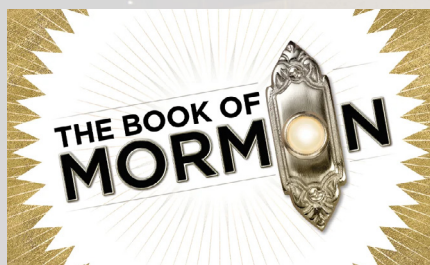
