



It's hard to believe that it has been seven years since Hamilton made its Bushnell debut! The memories from that time remain incredibly

vivid; there was unprecedented anticipation and excitement as the Box Office doors opened early on a September Saturday for the public on sale. The energy from that initial run in 2018, as well as the second stop here four years later, still resonate and those same feelings have now resurfaced again.

Beyond its status as one of the greatest blockbusters of all-time, *Hamilton* is a show that has left an indelible mark well beyond Broadway. Having just celebrated its 10th anniversary in August, its impact continues to reverberate throughout popular culture, education, and politics. In a retrospective to mark the show's milestone this past summer, *The New York Times* observed that although "some predictions about the 'Hamilton effect' have not panned out, the ones that did have dramatically altered musical theater, affecting casting, content, marketing, pricing, outreach, and even stardom."

It has been a remarkable achievement, and one that affirms the power of civic spaces, like The Bushnell. 


