

# MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT & CEO

## Leaving the World a Better Place



Welcome to The Bushnell for the next engagement in our Broadway Series, the inspirational and powerful,

*Suffs*. Created by Shaina

Taub, the first woman to independently win Tony Awards for Best Book and Best Score in the same season, the *Chicago Tribune* proclaimed, “Like all of the best Broadway musicals, *Suffs* humanizes, empowers, moves, and entertains.”

In the current issue of The Bushnell’s quarterly magazine *Muse*, there is a wonderful interview with Taub, detailing her years-long journey to bring *Suffs* to life. In answering the question of what she hopes young people take away from this experience, she shares, “Whether we are full-blown activists or whether we are just involved in our school, our church or synagogue, or even in our family or parenting, we are all trying to, in some way, *leave the world better than we found it.*”

I found that idea particularly poignant, both as it relates to the role The Bushnell continues to

play in our community and being on the precipice of Women’s History Month, which begins March 1. This year’s theme of “Leading the Change: Women Shaping a Sustainable Future” is particularly relevant to the story and messages of *Suffs*. As Taub adds, “The 19th Amendment ... was not an end result. We are still fighting for voting rights today. I hope young people walk away knowing that they can hold both of these truths: in one hand, how far we’ve come, and in the other hand, how far we still have to go.”

The Bushnell is so grateful to be a center where we can have important community discourse, share ideas, inspire change through the arts, and leave Hartford, as well as the entire region, in a better place for future generations. Thank you for being here, and I hope you enjoy this spectacular musical.
