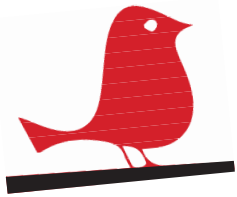

Waiting In Line



On the day of the
show, the lobby doors
will open at 11:00am.
I will have to stand in line.
with _____.
While waiting, we can talk
about how excited we are to
see the show. When it's our turn,
someone will check to see that we are
healthy and are wearing our **MASKS**.

Parking



We will park in a lot across the street
from the theater. Security staff will
be in the parking lot to show us
the way. We will use the crosswalk
when crossing the street.



Before leaving, I will make sure to have
my **MASK**. I will wear a **MASK** while at The Bushnell
to help keep myself and others safe and healthy.



Security



Inside the lobby doors, the security staff will check our bags.

Lobby



There are refreshment stands in the lobbies where I can buy snacks and drinks. Sometimes there is also a place where I can buy cool souvenirs from the show to take home.

I can eat and drink in the lobby but not in the theater.

Tickets



Next, an **USHER** will scan our tickets and show us the way into the lobby. The usher can also answer any questions we may have.

An **USHER** is someone who assists people in the theater to find their seats, the restrooms, and the exits.

Bathroom Break



Before I go into the theater, I can use the bathroom.

Elevator or Stairs



We may use an elevator or the stairs to get to our seats.

Seats



I will see another usher. I will hand my **TICKET** to the usher, so they can tell me where I will be sitting.

The numbers on our **TICKETS** tell us where we have to sit. It is not a choice.

Inside the Auditorium

I will go into the theater. The theater is big. There are a lot of seats in the theater.



Before The Show



I will hear an announcement, so I will know that the show is about to start. Then the theater will get darker and quiet. The show will start as the **ACTORS** come onto the stage.

ACTORS play characters and tell stories for an audience. They may sing and sometimes dance.

Clapping



After each song, some people like to **CLAP**. Sometimes the audience claps enthusiastically and the sound might get loud. If I want to clap, I can clap loudly, too!

CLAPPING tells the actors you liked their performance.

During The Show

I will try to stay in my seat and watch what's happening on the stage. If it gets a little scary, I can cover my eyes. If it gets too noisy, I can cover my ears, squeeze a fidget, hold _____'s hand, or hug _____.



And, if I need a little break, I can go to the "quiet area" in the lobby.

I will keep my **MASK** on to help myself and others stay safe.

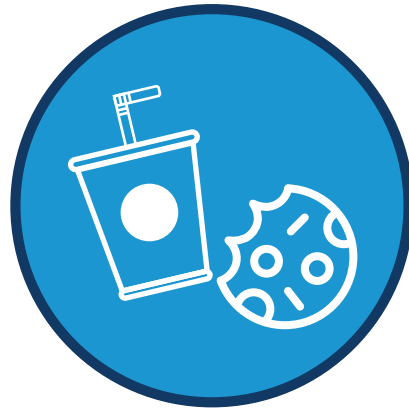
Exiting

When the show ends, everyone is going to be leaving the theater. I may have to wait my turn to leave. While I wait, I will stay with _____. We may go down the stairs or use the elevators to exit the building.

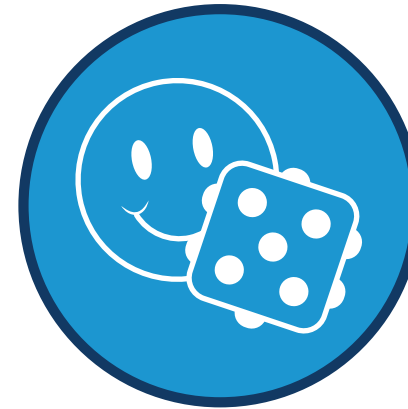




★ I will keep my **MASK** on at The Bushnell to help myself and others stay safe and healthy.
