

ACTORS pretend to be characters, people, or animals, in order to tell the story of the play. They wear costumes.

Clapping



After each song, some people like to **CLAP**. Sometimes the audience claps enthusiastically and the sound might get loud. If I want to clap, I can clap loudly, too!

CLAPPING tells the actors you liked their performance.

During the Show

I will try to stay in my seat and watch what's happening on the stage. If it gets a little scary, I can cover my eyes. If it gets too noisy, I can cover my ears, squeeze a fidget, hold 's
