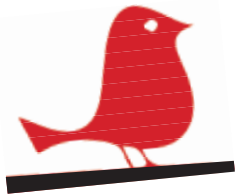

Waiting In Line

Parking

Security



Inside the lobby doors, the security staff will check our bags.

A **BAG CHECK** is done to make sure that people are not bringing in items that are not permitted in the theater.

Lobby



There are refreshment stands in the lobbies where I can buy snacks and drinks. Sometimes there is also a place where I can buy cool souvenirs from the show to take home.

Tickets



Next, an **USHER** will scan our tickets and show us the way into the lobby.

The usher can also answer any questions we may have.

An **USHER** is someone who assists people in the theater to find their seats, the restrooms, and the exits.

Bathroom Break



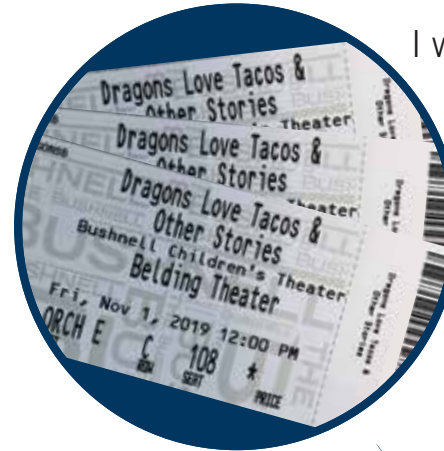
Before I go into the theater, I can use the bathroom or get a drink of water from the water fountain.

Elevator or Stairs



We may use an elevator or the stairs to get to our seats.

Seats



I will see another usher. I will hand my **TICKET** to the usher, so they can tell me where I will be sitting.

The numbers on our **TICKETS** tell us where we have to sit. It is not a choice.

Inside the Auditorium



I will go into the theater. The theater is big. There are a lot of seats in the theater.

Before The Show



I will hear an announcement, so I will know that the show is about to start. Then the theater will get darker and quiet. The show will start as the **MUSICIANS** come onto the stage.

MUSICIANS play music for an audience. They may sing and sometimes dance.

Clapping

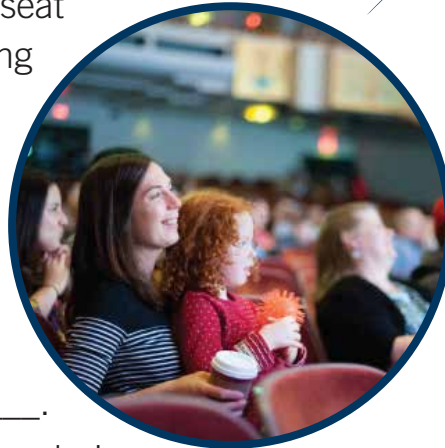


After each song, some people like to **CLAP**. Sometimes the audience claps enthusiastically and the sound might get loud. If I want to clap, I can clap loudly, too!

CLAPPING tells the musicians you liked their performance.

During The Show

I will try to stay in my seat and watch what's happening on the stage. If it gets a little scary, I can cover my eyes. If it gets too noisy, I can cover my ears, squeeze a fidget, hold _____'s hand, or hug _____.



And, if I need a little break, I can go to the "quiet area" in the lobby.

When the show ends, everyone is going to be leaving the theater. I may have to wait my turn to leave. While I wait, I will stay with _____. We may go down the stairs or use the elevators to exit the building.
